### STUDIO POLICIES AND NEWS

**ABSENCES:** Attendance is very important and instrumental to the development of your child's skills. If a student is not able to attend, we ask you to please call the office to report his/her absence. There are no refunds for missed classes.

**TUITION DUE DATE:** Tuition is always due the first class of the month. A 10% late fee will be applied to all tuition on the 16th. If you would like to set up credit card automatic payment, please stop at the office and someone can help you. There are no deductions or credits for missed classes. Withdrawals must be made before the first class of each month or you will be billed for the entire month.

**OBSERVATION:** is the last class in OCTOBER. Parents are welcome to sit and observe the classes. Please remember you are in a learning environment and we must keep noise to a minimum. Please look later in the newsletter for more information regarding October Halloween observation. Parent observation will be the same as last year and will be the months of October, December, February and April.

PRACTICE CD's AND MATERIALS: Cecchetti ballet & tap cd's for practice are available from the teachers for \$5.00. Cecchetti syllabus books are also available.
