Dance Lines 2018-19

Tryouts for jazz and tap lines will be held on November 11th. Pointe tryouts will be announced soon. Jazz and tap tryouts consist of technical skills and short combinations of various styles. Three to five judges are hired to score the tryouts. The scores from these tryouts are very important in deciding the lines for this season, specialties in the Christmas show and selecting our characters for the June production. Along with the following requirements attendance and work ethics can also factor into the final decisions. Age exceptions may be made by the staff for students whose Cecchetti levels are higher than average. All final decisions are left to the discretion of the dance faculty and staff reserves the right at any time to reevaluate a requirement due to extenuating circumstances.

Line Requirements and Guidelines

The following are recommendations for full participation on dance lines. Some schedules do not permit full participation and find their schedules must be tailored to meet their needs. There is room for everyone in the program but those limited to full activity may find not all opportunities can be applicable to them. Communication is the key. I understand many of you have interest outside the studio and do everything in your power to be here. Please discuss all conflicts and keep in mind the effects these conflicts have on your privileges. Dance is very disciplined and demanding but we hope it is also something that fills your soul and spirit and makes you the unique individuals that you.
