MEMORIAL DAY: There will be no classes on Memorial Day, Monday, May 27th. This is a vacation day set in your regular calendar schedule.

LAST DAY OF CLASSES: The last day of classes this year is Saturday, June 15th. **SUMMER REGISTRATION:** Please return registration forms for summer classes as soon as possible. Any scheduling information you can give us at this time will help us in creating the summer schedule. Classes will begin on June 24th for dance and July 1st for gymnastics.

FALL REGISTRATION: Remember to register for fall classes before July 1st to avoid an increase in the registration fee.

2024 Dance Show NEWS-"JUNGLE BOOK"

ATTENTION ALL LINE DANCERS: There is a mandatory \$50.00 assessment to all line dancers to help defray the cost of Scottish Rite Cathedral. This can be generated through any fundraisers (such as Raffle tickets, Gorant's candy, Dance-a-thon) or paid directly to the office. Each line family is also responsible for one ad in the dance program to defray the cost of the pictures in the program. Those families not submitting an ad will have a picture fee assessment of \$30.00.

AD FORM: Attached to this newsletter you will find an ad form for the 2024 Dance program. We are asking for your assistance in soliciting ads. Personal ads may also be placed. Please remember it is mandatory for all Dance Line members to solicit one ad for the program. Your help is great appreciated.

COSTUMES - Once your account is paid in full including costume balances, tuition, and all other charges, your children's costumes will be given to them in class to bring home. No costumes will be handed out until the balance is paid in full.

JUNGLE BOOK TICKET SALES: We will be selling tickets for the "Jungle Book" show at the studio starting on Wednesday, May 15th. When you arrive at the studio, please come in and sign your name on the sign in sheet by group: Senior Line, Pre-Senior Line, Teen Line, Junior Line, open students. No one will be at the studio before 8:00 on ticket sale day. Beginning on Monday, May 20th, tickets will also be available online.

Tickets will be available to purchase in person at the studio from Wednesday, May 15th until the show, there will be NO online sales until Monday, May 20. When purchasing tickets, you may pay with cash, check or charge. Ticket prices are \$23.50 plus \$1.50 in fees charged by the Cathedral. Tickets are reserved seating so please know how many seats you need for each night's performance. If your child is in kindercise or kinderdance, you will receive a ticket (at no charge) for them to sit with you after their performance. In order to receive a free ticket for your kindercise or kinderdance student, you MUST purchase your tickets at the studio. Otherwise, you will be charged for their ticket, there are no comped tickets online. Please make sure you know which night you need tickets.

Anyone selling 10 tickets will receive a complimentary ticket, and a trophy so make sure your eleventh ticket is with your seats. If you are purchasing ten or more tickets and want your free ticket, you MUST purchase your tickets at the studio. NO comp tickets will be available online. Only one trophy per family is awarded for selling 10 tickets. If you would like to purchase another trophy for a second child for \$8.00, please contact the office. You may only receive a trophy if you sell ten tickets. You are not able to just purchase a ticket trophy. Anyone selling 20 tickets will receive two complimentary tickets and a \$50 gift certificate towards classes over the summer or next fall.

SUMMER DANCE CAMPS FOR YOUNG STUDENTS



The weekend of April 27-28, we had two gymnasts go to the regional meet in LaGrange, Illinois, outside of Chicago. At this meet, Emily Zimbardi and Lauren Wright were competing against the qualifiers from five states: Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Illinois and Michigan. This can be an intimidating experience, but both girls did very well against very tough competition. Lauren Wright scored a 9.2 on vault, 9.45 on floor and had an all-around score of 35.375. Emily Zimbardi placed 11th on vault with a 9.250, 4th on bars with a 9.250, 1st on beam with a 9.80 and 2nd on floor with a 9.575. Emily also placed 1st all-around with a 37.875. We have a regional champion on balance beam and all-around!! We are so proud of both of these girls and the continued hard work they put in with their teammates.
